Superintendent Hocking discussed the Superintendent Search. An initial meeting took place on December 3rd with both the Lisbon and Springville School Boards to screen candidates. We received 19 applications and the pool has been narrowed down to 7. Initial zoom interviews will take place on January 5th and the Boards will narrow the pool down to 3 finalists. Final interviews will take place on January 26th.

Elementary Principal Brown discussed the recent Elementary Band Concert, and noted the amount of growth from 5th to 6th grade. It's clear that Mr. Arch loves what he does, and so do the students. We have a PBIS Santa Cam, and an assembly coming up on Dec. 22nd. The Elementary Holiday Concert is next week, and we

He also attended the recent Iowa Association of School Boards conference with new Board member Richey.
