Assistant Principal Horman led discussion on the exploration of the River Valley Conference for the 2026-27 school year.

Discussion took place regarding Teacher and Staff Recognition. Superintendent Pino thanked all teachers and staff for supporting our students every day and stated that everyone is needed. Board President Caspers expressed her appreciation to all teachers who also support the work study program. The younger students really look up to the high school students.

He also spoke about and thanked the Community for their support again with the Teeling Memorial Walk-a-Thon. Approximately \$14,000 was raised and goes directly back to the kids. Testing results and report cards will be mailed out in June. He also thanked the School Board for everything they do, their vision, and for putting kids first.

Assistant Principal Horman gave a report on the following: Allstate Jazz Band and the great progress with gold and track season. Thank you to all of the community volunteers for stepping up to help run the track meets. Thank you to all the School Board members for devoting so many hours.

Superintendent Pino gave a report on the progress with Champions. They plan to open on July 1st. We are appreciative of their flexibility and helping promote Lisbon pride. She thanked Bre Ties and Bre Hoge for their work to task things out with all the details that are involved. Superintendent Pino also spoke about the huge honor it was for the Lisbon Concert Band to be invited to play at the IBA Conference. Congratulations to Mr Arch and Mrs Stulken for building a great band program.
