President Caspers called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Motion by Baker, second by Prasil to approve the Agenda. All ayes motion carried (5-0).

Motion by Prasil, second by Mallie to enter Public Hearing at 6:02 p.m.

No comments were made.

Motion by Baker, second by Richey to exit Public Hearing at 6:03 p.m.

Motion by Mallie, second by Baker to approve the Continuation of the Instructional Support Levy as presented. A roll call vote was taken as follows: Allan Mallie - aye, Jen Caspers - aye, John Baker - aye, Robyn Richey - aye, John Prasil - aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Prail, second by Baker to approve the First Reading of IASB Policy Primer Vol 33#4. All ayes motion carried (5-0).

Motion by Mallie, second by Richey to approve the First Reading of 300 Policy Series. All ayes motion carried (5-0).

Motion by Prasil, second by Mallie to approve the First Reading of 400 Policy Series. All ayes motion carried (5-0).

Motion by Richey, second by Baker to approve the Second Reading/Adoption of Policy 503.09. All ayes motion carried (5-0).

Motion by Prasil, second by Mallie to approve the 2025-26 Secondary Handbook. All ayes motion carried (5-0).

Motion by Mallie, second by Baker to approve the 2025-26 Acceptable Use Policies (AUP). All ayes motion carried (5-0).

Motion by Prasil, second by Mallie to approve the Resolution for the Transfer of Safety Equipment Funds as presented. All ayes motion carried (5-0).

Motion by Prasil, second by Mallie to approve the Activities Conference Change to RVC. Discussion took place. Richey stated that she was unsure if this was the right time for this change to happen. Caspers shared that she felt some uncertainty with this decision and acknowledged regardless of the vote outcome the board would remain supportive of the final decision. Superintendent Pino also acknowledged that sometimes a decision comes down to a lean in either direction and not a clear black or white answer. Regardless, we will create supportive conditions for our students to be successful and thrive. She also thanked our Athletic Directors and Board for the extensive research they did related to this topic. Board Members Baker and Mallie gave a facility plan update to include: the progress on the kitchen remodel is going great with a slight chance that it will be done prior to the start of school, they are continuing to look into the replacement of the dishwasher in the kitchen, the majority of the punch list items from construction have been taken care of and some items are being corrected under warranty, the legacy hallway facelift is looking great and will be finished with the reinstallation of the pictures and trophies.

Secondary Principal Leighty gave a report on the following: Teachers are back in the building to work their flex days, the new teachers started today, and the 4 main goals that the PLC team will work toward this school year.

Elementary Principal Brown gave a report on the following: the Elementary Student Improvement Plan and the results from the last year, reviewed legislative and handbook changes for the 25-26 school year, back to school night will be 8/20 4:30-6:30 pm, communication has been sent to families regarding the use of elementary entrance, the use of Frontline for subs for this school year, and school supply kits have been delivered - Thanks to Steph and Marilyn for handing those out.

Assistant Principal Horman gave a report on athletics progress - August is a busy month of planning for the coming seasons. A lot of communication will be going out over the next couple weeks. The new weight equipment is due to be delivered in September and the old equipment will be taken out by an auctioneer. Thank you to Levi and Brandon for installing the new wall mats in the Lions Den - they look great!

Superintendent Pino discussed the following: Robyn Raper was hired for the new web coordinator position, back to school work is under way, compliments to the admin team on their work with staff training regarding bullying and harrasment, the staff address will be a workshop style focused on growth and systems thinking.
