December 10, 2025 – Lisbon Pride Room – 6:00 p.m.

President Caspers called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Motion by Richey, second by Prasil to approve the Agenda. All ayes motion carried (5-0).

Motion by Baker, second by Prasil to approve the authorization of the Lisbon CSD district administration to submit a request to the School Budget Review Committee for a modified supplemental amount of \$138,271; for open enrolled out students who were not included in the district's previous-year certified enrollment count. All ayes motion carried (5-0).

Motion by Prasil, second by Richey to approve the Early Retirement Offering as presented. All ayes motion carried (5-0).

Board Member Baker gave a facility update on the following: final walk through for the construction punch list will happen next week, continued work on the facility maintenance plan, and a snow removal plan.

Board Member Prasil added that it has been a great addition to home games to have the music students perform the anthem - kudos to them for doing a great job.

She also thanked J'nee Reade and all of her students for their hard work in making Project 60 the great success it has been for the community.
