President Caspers called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Motion by Baker, second by Prasil to approve the Agenda. All ayes motion carried (4-0).

Motion by Baker, second by Richey to approve the 7-12 Activities Director Position as presented. All ayes motion carried (4-0).
