WHAT IS IT?

PBIS stands for Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports. It is a positive and proactive way to address student behavior. At Lisbon, we call it LION BASICS: RESPECTFUL, RESPONSIBLE, SAFE, & CARING.

These expectations are taught and reinforced daily. Individual students or entire classes following Lion Basics are acknowledged with two different types of tickets.

YELLOW TICKETS are earned for respectful, responsible, safe & caring choices by INDIVIDUAL STUDENTS throughout the school building.

Examples of positive behaviors:

Classroom - raising hand to share answer

Hallway - walking feet

Lunchroom - using manners

Recess - including others in play

Office - waiting patiently & quietly for help

Students collect earned tickets to purchase items/coupons in their classroom or from the PBIS prize cart.

RED TICKETS are awarded when an ENTIRE CLASS exhibits Lion Basics. Each class works to fill their red ticket chart & earn a special red ticket PARTY!

WHAT CAN YOU DO?

- 👉 Ask your child what he/she did to be respectful, responsible, safe, & caring each day.
- 👉 Use the same LION BASICS language at home & encourage good manners.
- 👉 Celebrate school successes at home to further reinforce positive choices.
- 👉 Keep in touch with your student's teacher and ask how you can better help from home.
